She was built at Swan Hunter shipyards in Newcastle upon Tyne. When construction started in 1942 she was intended as a merchant ship, but was completed and launched as an escort carrier, entering service at the end of 1943. HMS Vindex (D15) - Wikipedia Mercantile hull requisitioned for Admiralty service on 20th October 1942 whilst under construction by Swan Hunter at Newcastle for the Port Line. The Ship was to be converted for use as an Escort Aircraft Carrier and designated Job Number 4698. Launched on 4th May 1943 as HMS VINDEX her build completed on 3rd December that year. HMS Vindex, British escort aircraft carrier, WW2 Vindex and Nairana were both commissioned within days of each other in December 1943, and moved to Gourock for working up. Nairana with 835 Naval Air Squadron Fleet Air Arm on board commenced flying exercises with HMS Activity on 27 January 1944. Both carriers left the River Clyde on 29 January with the 2nd Escort Group under the command of Captain Frederic John Walker.
