Perceived differences between mental health problems and mental illness. Some people responded to each of these terms simply by referring its opposite - for example, 'mental health' was 'not being mentally ill'. Others tended to use the terms interchangeably. However, despite the frequent blending of the terms 'mental health' and 'mental illness', numbers of young people did draw

distinctions between 'mental health problems' and 'mental illnesses' in more extended discussions. 2.3.1 Knowledge, attitudes and perceptions of mental ... From a public standpoint, stereotypes depicting people with mental illness as being dangerous, unpredictable, responsible for their illness, or generally incompetent can lead to active discrimination, such as excluding people with these conditions from employment and social or educational opportunities.
